

What happens at my first eye test?

What happens at the opticians?

At your visit we'll check your eyes to make sure you can see clearly.

Who will I meet?

First you'll meet our receptionist who'll ask you your name. Then you'll see our optician who'll check your eyes.

What will I have to do?

You'll go into a room to see your optician with mummy/daddy and you can sit in a big chair. The optician will show you some letters, numbers, pictures (depending on your age) and ask you what you can see. The optician will need to turn the lights out at some point, so you can see the pictures more easily. They may also look into your eyes with a special light.

What happens if I need glasses?

We have lots of glasses in different colours and sizes and you can have fun trying them on. We will then take some measurements of your eyes and your head to make sure that your new glasses fit you and that they'll be comfortable. You will then be able to collect your glasses once they're ready.

Can I get sunglasses to fit me?
